GUIDELINES TO AUTHORS

The Proceedings of the 2008 Workshop on the Nile Basin hydrology and Ecology under Extreme Climatic Conditions will be published in CD-ROM and limited number of hard copies. Completed papers must be submitted by **March 15, 2008** to wabtew@aol.com. Failure to mail completed papers on time may cause your paper not to appear in the Proceedings. Please follow these guidelines exactly. We have a tight production schedule and papers not in compliance may be left out of the Proceedings.

REQUIREMENTS FOR FULL PAPERS AND EXPANDED ABSTRACTS

1. Papers should be e-mailed as a file attachment in a Microsoft Word format (DOC format). Successful receipt of your paper will be acknowledged by reply email. Please include your telephone number in the email so that we can contact you if needed.
2. At least one author must attend the workshop for papers or abstracts to be included in the Proceedings.
3. Do not use footnotes and headers, endnotes, the Word Markup or auto-format features, or any extraneous formatting. Do not use any document-level commands that would interfere with the combination of your paper with other papers in a common file.
4. All papers must have abstract no more than 250 words.
5. Expanded Abstracts can be as long as two pages with brief references included.
6. Full paper length should be limited to 12 pages, single spaced.
7. Lines should be single spaced and Paragraphs be indented and separated by a double space. Use left justification with 1" margins all around.
8. When citing references within the text please use the formats; at end of sentence (Raymond, 2007) or beginning and middle of sentence, Raymond (2007).

9. Tables, figures and charts should be inserted in the text as a picture/graphic format (jpeg, tif, etc.) formatted to be dragged around. Place all tables and figures in the body of the text with captions.

10. The final heading is REFERENCES. Please use the following format:

Peggy, A.J. and D. Curtis. 1994. Water Balance of Blue Nile Basin in Ethiopia. Journal of Irrigation and Drainage Engineering. Vol. 120(3):573-590.
Snedecor, G.W. and W.G. Cochran. 1980. Statistical Methods. The Iowa State University Press. Ames, Iowa.

Website references should be cited in the body of the text and need not be included in the REFERENCES section.

11. Spell check and correct all grammatical errors before sending paper.

12. Paper must follow the following format with Times New Roman font:

TITLE OF PAPER (12 point bold, cap, centered)

Author one¹ and Author two² (11 point, bold, centered)

²**Engineer, The Engineering Company, City, Country** (11 point, bold, centered)

ABSTRACT (11 point, bold, cap, centered)

INTRODUCTION (11 point, bold, cap, centered)

EXPERIMENT (11 point, bold, cap, centered) Level One Heading

Data Analysis (11 point, bold, first letter cap, left justified) Level two Heading

Statistical Method (11 point, italics, first letters cap, left justified) Level three Heading

Variance Analysis (11 point, first letters cap, underlined, left justified) Level four Heading

CONCLUSION (11 point, bold, cap, centered)

REFERENCES (11 point, bold, cap, centered)
